2009/2010 INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FUNDING POLICY

Overview

This policy outlines the funding that will be provided to skaters from the National and/or Development Team that are selected to compete internationally representing Singapore for the period from the 1st April 2009 through to the 30th March 2010.

All funding will be provided to the Athlete at the conclusion of the competition at which they are attending, upon the athlete completing and submitting the relevant application funding form to the SISA Administrator.

Funding Allocation

- It should be noted that skaters attending ISU Championship or Grand Prix events have their accommodation and meals supplied throughout the competition.
- Skaters attending any other international competitions must supply and fund themselves the accommodation and meals throughout the competition.
- Only the competitions listed will be funded, other international competitions will be provided base funding on a case-by-case basis.
- Skaters attending the listed competitions will also be entitled to bonus funding, for achievement of various milestones and results.

Junior Grand Prix Event	\$1200
Four Continents	\$1200
Junior World Championships	\$1200
Senior World Championships	\$1200
Winter Games – New Zealand	\$1700

Bonus Funding

Personal Bests at Grand Prix, Junior Grand Prix or Winter Games (*)	\$200 per skater
Personal Bests at Worlds or Junior Worlds (*)	\$300 per skater
Execute a double axel jump at Grand Prix, Junior Grand Prix, Winter Games, Worlds or Junior Worlds (#)	\$200 per skater
Execute a triple jump or triple combination jump at Grand Prix, Junior Grand Prix, Winter Games, Worlds or Junior Worlds (#)	\$500 per skater

Bonuses

(*) Personal Best Bonuses will be rewarded as follows:

1. The skaters Total Overall Score/s in either the Short and/or Free Program is greater than their previous Personal Best score/s (in Short and/or Free Program) achieved at the listed international competitions previously within the 2009/2010 competition season.
2. A skater who has not competed at international competitions during the 2009/2010 season and their score/s (Short and/or Free Program) is greater than their Personal Best score/s (Short and/or Free Program) achieved at 2009 Singapore National Figure Skating Championships.
3. The bonus will be rewarded once per competition when either points 1 or 2 above are met.

(#) The bonus will be rewarded up to twice per competition segment (short and free skate) when:

1. The skater is credited with the base value for the jump or jump combination (no downgrades) and
2. The Grade of Execution for the element has a trimmed mean greater than or equal to (-1) from the judges scores.
