## Policy Document: 202-V1



### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

#### Overview

This policy establishes guidelines used to eligibility of skaters for nomination to ISU sanctioned Adult International Competitions. Skaters eligible for these events must be eligible to represent Singapore at international events.

#### Singapore Citizens

- The skater must compete at the Singapore National Figure Skating Championships.
- Be a current financial member of SISA.

#### Non-Singapore Citizens (Singapore Permanent Residents)

- The skater must comply with ISU Rule 109 as per residency requirements, and have obtained all necessary releases prior to the Singapore National Figure National Championships.
- The skater must compete in the Singapore National Figure Skating Championships and be a current financial member of SISA.

#### SISA Membership

- Skaters seeking to compete in the Singapore National Figure Skating Championships, other than as a guest skater, or to represent Singapore internationally must be a current financial member of SISA for a period of 3 months prior to the Singapore National Figure Skating Championships.

#### National Championship Eligibility

- Skaters seeking to enter into the Singapore National Figure Skating Championships, other than as a guest skater and/or seeking nomination to International Adult Competitions, must have passed the required SISA qualifying test for that championship level prior to the commencement of the National Championships.
  - Example, a skater who wishes to compete in the Novice Division of the Championship, they must pass the SISA Novice Test prior to the commencement of the National Championships.
  - If the test is not passed prior to the commencement of the Championship then the skater will only be able to skate in that section as a Guest, and will not be eligible for nomination to any International Adult Competitions.
