The Singapore Ice Skating Association has once again been invited by the Singapore National Olympic Council and the Gangwon Provincial Government, Korea to participate in the Korean Dream Program 2012. The Korean hosts have specified that Singapore may send three (3) skaters, who must be between the ages of 11-15 years old (as of 1 November 2011). They must also be a Singaporean citizen or a permanent resident of Singapore. One coach or team leader will accompany the participants.

The Korean Dream Program promotes exchange of culture and friendship among youth from all over the world so that they will realize harmony of mankind and world peace through sports. The program will run from 6 – 19 February 2012.

There will be 200 participants from 46 countries. The sports that they will introduce are skiing, snowboarding, short track speed skating, and figure skating. There will be a mixture of skating and cultural activities organized by the host country.

Criteria for selection:

- This program is only open to SISA members.
- Interested skaters must opt in by Singapore time 9:00am on Friday 4 November 2011 by submitting their name and contact number via email to the SISA Administration Officer at [administration@sisa.org.sg](mailto:administration@sisa.org.sg)
- Interested skaters must have a valid passport.
- Participants will be selected through a draw on the 4 November at 9:30am on Friday 4 November 2011 at 27 Holland Grove Drive, Singapore 278870. Interested parties are welcome to witness the draw.
- Successful applicants will be notified immediately after the draw.
- All successful applicants must sign the SISA Code of Ethics; any misbehaviour will be dealt with by SISA in consultation with SNOC and SSC.
- Successful applicants and/or one parent must make themselves available to attend a briefing and commit to submitting all necessary original documents and duly completed application forms as required by our Korean hosts, latest by 10.30am on Friday 11 November 2011 at 27 Holland Grove Drive, Singapore 278870, and a scanned copy of all documents and forms to [administration@sisa.org.sg](mailto:administration@sisa.org.sg)
- All expenses are covered, including return tickets, accommodation, meals, uniforms and equipment rental for the training will be provided by Gangwon Province.
- Participants are responsible to obtain their own entry visa to enter the Republic of Korea if necessary.
