

**SISA TECHNICAL SG-COACH COURSES
(FIGURE SKATING)
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (2016)**

OBJECTIVE:

SISA targets to qualify more Figure Skating coaches through progressive accreditation. Figure Skating coaches should ideally have been competitive skaters of a certain level to be able to relate to their students the mechanics required in the sport of figure skating as well as in the interpretations of rules stipulated by the governing body, the International Skating Union (ISU).

This document is a criteria for applicants for SG-Coach technical training conducted by Singapore Ice Skating Association (SISA).

SG-COACH TECHNICAL LEVEL 1

1. Interested applicants must be at least 16 years of age at the time of registration.
2. You should have personally passed at least one of following level tests:
 - SISA Elementary Level Test
 - Equivalent figure skating tests from other countries
 - OR ONE (1) of your students must have passed one of the above-mentioned level tests
3. If application is on the basis of your student's level standing,
 - you must have coached that student for a minimum of one (1) year and have been his/her primary coach for that period of time
 - the student's relevant test must have been satisfied within a period of five (5) years prior to the submission of application
4. If applicant does not qualify criteria 2 and 3, he/she must be able to perform the following elements to qualify for the course:
 - ✓ Waltz Jump
 - ✓ Salchow
 - ✓ 1 Foot Spin
 - ✓ 3 Turns and brackets
 - ✓ Proficient Stroking Skill

SG-COACH TECHNICAL LEVEL 2

1. Interested applicants must be at least 16 years of age at the time of registration.
2. You must be holder of a recognized SG-Coach Technical Level 1 Certificate or equivalent and a registered coach under NROC.
3. Interested applicants must be proficient in the content taught in SG-Coach Technical Level 1 and should be able to demonstrate/ explain techniques proficiently.
4. You should have personally passed at least one of following level tests:
 - SISA Primary (Novice B) Level Test
 - Equivalent figure skating tests from other countriesOR ONE (1) of your students must have passed one of the above-mentioned level tests.
5. If application is on the basis of your student's level standing,
 - you must have coached that student for a minimum of two (2) years and have been his/her primary coach for that period of time
 - the student's relevant test must have been satisfied within a period of five (5) years prior to the submission of application

SG-COACH TECHNICAL LEVEL 3 (Currently Unavailable)

1. Interested applicants must be at least 16 years of age at the time of registration.
2. You must be holder of a recognized SG-Coach Technical Level 2 Certificate or equivalent and a registered NROC coach.
3. Interested applicants must be proficient in the content taught in SG-Coach Technical Level 2 and should be able to demonstrate/ explain techniques proficiently.
4. You should have personally passed at least one of following level tests:
 - SISA Junior Level Test
 - Equivalent figure skating tests from other countriesOR ONE (1) of your students must have passed one of the above-mentioned level tests.
5. If application is on the basis of your student's level standing,
 - you must have coached that student for a minimum of two (2) years and have been his/her primary coach for that period of time
 - the student's relevant test must have been satisfied within a period of five (5) years prior to the submission of application
