Dear Figure Skating Community,

Any members who missed out on gaining the necessary score for selection for the Development / International Squad during Nationals are still able to gain a place, by obtaining the necessary score at nominated competitions, as per the selection policy.

Other non-ISU listed competitions in the region, e.g.: Asian Challenge, other National Championships

Unfortunately due to no prior knowledge of the makeup of the panels (judging and technical) prior to the competition we cannot automatically state that these competitions will be suitable to compete at to gain a score. If you do compete at them, please submit the details to SISA after the competition for the Selection Panel to evaluate.

Competitions in Australia

Australia has certain requirements for the Technical and Judging Panels that are required to be met for events in Australia that are listed as Benchmark events. Australian skaters can skate at these events and also gain a score for selection for Australian squads.

SISA can leverage off these events for our skaters who which to compete in them and their score will automatically be recognised for selection to the Development / International Squads.

- NSW State Championships – Penrith (Sydney) – 1st – 3rd October
- QLD State Championships – Brisbane – 12th – 15th October
- 2016 Australian Figure Skating Championships – 26 November – 2 December 2016
